



## 2020 SCHOOL FEES

After careful consideration, the Community Council has approved the 2020 School Fee Schedule. This includes the ACT Primary Tuition Fee and the Catholic Schools Building Fund Fee set by the Catholic Education Commission.

The following schedule of fees and payment options is provided to allow you to begin regular payments early in 2020. Direct Debit forms to either commence or amend your current agreement are available from our website. Please complete and return forms to the Front Office as soon as possible. Term school fee invoices will be sent home in Week 1 and are expected to be paid in full by Week 5, unless a Direct Debit is in place.

Thank you for providing financial support through payment of school fees which enables St Clare of Assisi to provide a quality Catholic Education for your child/ren.

### Tuition Fees

This fee is set by the Catholic Education Commission. The Catholic Education Office retains over 90% of the collected amount. These funds are used to pay staff and provide system support for our school. The Catholic Education Commission ACT Archdiocesan Tuition Fees for 2020 are listed in the table below.

A further 20% discount applies to the first child fee where there is a sibling in one of the following systemic secondary colleges, John Paul College, Merici College, St Clare's College, St Francis Xavier College and St Mary MacKillop College.

### Building Fund – Fully Tax Deductible

The Building Fund is a fully tax deductible contribution payable by the eldest child at a systemic school. Funds raised by the building fund pay for all maintenance, upkeep and security of the buildings. Please note that Marist, St Edmund's and Daramalan are NOT systemic schools.

### School Based Fees

These are retained by the school and used for the following purposes:

Cleaning/Maintenance Fee	Cleaning, waste management, janitor, grounds, etc
ICT Fee	Computers, iPads, internet charges, subscriptions, security, resources
Community Council Fee	Community events, Resources and equipment for school
School Improvement Fee	School Loans, building maintenance, provisions for future development
Admin Fee	Electricity, water, gas, security, first aid, office supplies
Resource Fee	Books, stationary, paper, photocopier, consumables, art supplies
Enrichment Fee	Excursions, incursions, enrichment, activities
Water Safety Program	<i>A voluntary program for students in Kindergarten – Year 2 only</i>

### School Based Fees

The school has great plans for 2020, and has carefully cut costs where possible, thereby limiting increases to approximately \$2.30 per week. In keeping fees to a minimum, we are also looking forward to the following initiatives in 2020:

- New, student centred, furniture in all Years 2 classrooms
- 60 new iPads for use in all year levels
- Landscaping and grounds improvement in Junior Equipment and grassed area (outside OSHC)
- Dedicated dance lessons (in line with Australian curriculum) for all year levels
- Professional Learning for staff to implement Sounds Write (a phonological approach to teaching spelling)
- Student centred learning team to focus on Literacy and Numeracy development across the school

### Payments
